Data Protection Statement Western Balkan EDIF Platform

Personal data are processed by the European Investment Fund ("EIF" or "Controller") in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data, as such regulation may be amended from time to time.

1. Legal Basis

The Western Balkans Enterprise Development and Innovation Facility ("WB EDIF Platform") was launched in 2012 by the European Commission ("EC") as a joint initiative, with the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development ("EBRD"), the European Investment Bank ("EIB") and the European Investment Fund ("EIF") as co-lead financial institutions.

Under a Coordination Agreement signed between the EC and EIF, EIF ensures, among others tasks, the secretariat of the WB EDIF Platform.

Data Subjects

Data subjects are professionals and other individuals acting as contact persons of the European Commission ("EC"), the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development ("EBRD"), the European Investment Bank ("EIB"), other international financial institutions and any other relevant stakeholders from Western Balkan countries participating to the WB EDIF Platform.

3. Purpose

The personal data referred to herein are collected for knowledge sharing and information exchange purposes.

4. <u>Data Categories</u>

The referred personal data comprise information on the details of the contact persons.

5. <u>Data Recipients</u>

The aforementioned personal data shall be processed by EIF ensuring the secretariat of the WB EDIF Platform.

6. Data Retention Period

<u>Data Subjects' personal data will be retained up to ten (10) years after the termination the WB EDIF Coordination Agreement between EIF and the EC.</u>

7. Rights of Data Subject

- Data Subjects have the right to obtain from the controller confirmation as to whether or not their
 personal data concerning are being processed, and, where that is the case, access their personal
 data by contacting the Controller (info@eif.org) or through the EIF DPO (dpo@eif.org) and they
 will receive a response without undue delay (right of access);
- Data Subjects have the right to obtain from the controller without undue delay the rectification of any inaccurate personal data concerning them (right to rectification).
- Data Subjects have the right to obtain from the controller the erasure of their personal data when they are no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which they were collected (right to erasure);
- Data Subjects have the right to obtain from the controller restriction of processing when (i) they contest the accuracy of their personal data, (ii) the processing is unlawful, (iii) the controller no longer needs the personal data for the purposes of the processing or (iv) they have objected to



- processing, pending the verification whether the legitimate grounds of the controller override theirs (right to restriction of processing);
- Data Subjects have the right to object, on grounds relating to their particular situation, when the processing of personal data is unlawful;
- Data Subjects have the right to receive from the controller their personal data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and transmit those data to another controller without hindrance from the controller to which the personal data have been provided (right to data portability);
- Data Subjects have the right to withdraw their consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal
- Data Subjects may lodge a complaint to the European Data Protection Supervisor (<u>www.edps.europa.eu</u>) at any time (**right to lodge a complaint**).
