Final Status of CIP SMEG implementation

- **69** contracts signed ⁽¹⁾
 - covering **23** countries ⁽²⁾
 - for a total (counter-) guarantee amount of EUR **507.2m**
- Has provided EUR **21,231.5m** of financing to SMEs
- Currently enabling the support of **389,988** SMEs and **1,359,142** jobs




